TOURNAMENT RULES AND INFORMATION

ALL TOURNAMENT COMPETITION WILL BE IN STRICT COMPLIANCE WITH USBC RULES

*This event is certified by the United States Bowling Congress (USBC).
Any USBC-certified tournament rule not explicitly stated, waived, or modified in these rules will apply to this tournament where applicable.*

ELIGIBILITY - The Central New York USBC Senior Alibi Championship is open to all members in good standing with the National USBC Association and is conducted under USBC rules and regulations. Participants must be certified by the USBC for the current 2024-2025 season and must be 50 or older as of December 1, 2024. Local Dues will be waived for USBC members who are not Central New York USBC Association members. Proof of eligibility may be required.

HANDICAP & ENTERING AVERAGE - Handicap will be based on 90% of the participant's entering average and 220. The entering average will be the participant's HIGHEST USBC certified average for 21 games or more from either the 2023-2024 or 2022-2023 season, whether from a regular or senior league. Spring or summer league averages will be considered. Those with averages of 220 or higher will bowl scratch (with no handicap). **Please note that any entrant without an average from the 2023-2024 or 2022-2023 seasons will bowl scratch.** USBC Rule 319-a-2 (10-pin rule) is in effect for this tournament.

AVERAGE ADJUSTMENT & VERIFICATION - All participants are required to familiarize themselves with the provisions of USBC Rule 319e, pertaining to **re-rating**, and will be governed by application of that rule.

IT SHALL BE EACH BOWLER'S RESPONSIBILITY TO VERIFY THE ACCURACY OF THEIR AVERAGE BEFORE BOWLING. FAILURE TO USE THE CORRECT AVERAGE SHALL DISQUALIFY THE SCORE IF THE SUBMITTED AVERAGE IS LOWER THAN THE CORRECT AVERAGE, THEREBY RESULTING IN A LOWER CLASSIFICATION OR MORE HANDICAP. PRIZE WINNINGS WILL BE BASED ON THE SUBMITTED AVERAGE IF IT IS HIGHER THAN THE CORRECT AVERAGE (Rule 319a-3).

A participant must report previous tournament winnings over \$600.00 in any event of any tournament between December 1, 2023, and December 1, 2024. Information provided must include the actual score, the position of finish in the event, the event's name, and the amount won. Tournament Management reserves the right to adjust, re-rate, or reject any entrant before participation.

PARTICIPATION FORMAT – Participants will bowl four games consecutively on the same pair, dropping the lowest game, for a 3-game total with handicap. The top one-in-four in each division will then continue to bowl elimination style to determine the top qualifier in each division. Division winners will then bowl each other until an overall winner is determined.

MISCELLANEOUS –

- NO touring level 1 or 2 professionals may compete in the tournament.
- Re-entries are not allowed.
- Before the start of each squad, the tournament director will assign lanes. In most cases, six bowlers will be placed on each pair of lanes.
- Lanes will be stripped and oiled before the first squad only.

PRIZES AND AWARDS - PRIZE FEES WILL BE RETURNED 100%. The prize ratio will be at least one prize for each five (1:5) entries, in each event. All prizes will be paid for scores with handicap.
